INTROIT: ALL that Thou hast done to us, O Lord, Thou hast done in true judgment; because we have sinned against Thee, and we have not obeyed Thy commandments: but give glory to Thy name, and deal with us according to the multitude of Thy mercy. *Ps.* Blessed are the undefiled in the way; who walk in the law of the Lord. *∞.* Glory...

COLLECT: Bestow upon Thy faithful people pardon and peace, we beseech Thee, merciful Lord, that they may be both cleansed from all their sins and serve Thee with a quiet mind. Through our Lord.

OFFERTORY: Upon the rivers of Babylon there we sat and wept; when we remembered Thee, O Sion.

SECRET: May these mysteries, we beseech Thee, O Lord, bring us a heavenly remedy and root out all vice from our hearts. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION: Be Thou mindful of Thy word to Thy servant, O Lord, in which Thou hast given me hope: this hath comforted me in my humiliation.

POST-COMMUNION: That we may become worthy, O Lord, to receive Thy holy gifts, make us ever, we beseech Thee, obedient to Thy commandments. Through our Lord.
