

# Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite

## The 24<sup>th</sup> & Last Sunday after Pentecost – November 21, 2010

*“and he will send forth His angels with a trumpet . . .”*

**INTROIT** *Jeremias 29. 11, 12, 14.* The Lord saith: I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction: you shall call upon Me, and I will hear you; and I will bring back your captivity from all places. – (*Psalm 84. 2*). Lord, Thou hast blessed Thy land: Thou hast turned away the captivity of Jacob. V. Glory be . . . – The Lord saith: I think thoughts of peace . . .

**COLLECT** O almighty and everlasting God, look mercifully upon our weakness: and stretch forth the right hand of Thy Majesty to protect us. Through our Lord . . .

**EPISTLE** *Romans 12. 16-21.* Brethern, Be not wise in your own conceits. To no man rendering evil for evil: providing good things not only in the sight of God, but also in the sight of all men. If it be possible, as much as is in you, have peace with all men. Revenge not yourselves, beloved, but give place unto wrath. For it is written: Revenge is Mine: I will repay, saith the Lord. But if thine enemy is hungry, give him to eat; if he thirst, give him drink: for by doing this, thou shalt heap coals of fire upon his head. Be not overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

**GRADUAL** *Psalm 43. 8, 9.* Thou hast delivered us, O Lord, from them that afflict us: and hast put them to shame that hate us. V. In God we will glory all the day: and in Thy Name we will give praise forever.

Alleluia, alleluia. V. (*Psalm 129, 1. 2*). From the depths I have cried to Thee, O Lord: Lord, hear my prayer. Alleluia.

**GOSPEL** *Matthew 8. 1-13.* At that time, when Jesus was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him: and behold a leper came and adored Him, saying: Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean. And Jesus, stretching forth His hand, touched him, saying: I will. Be thou made clean. And forthwith his leprosy was cleansed. And Jesus saith to him:

See, thou tell no man: but go, show thyself to the priest, and offer the gift which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them. And when he had entered into Capharnaum, there came to him a centurion, beseeching Him, and saying: Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, and is grievously tormented. And Jesus saith to him: I will come and heal him. And the centurion making answer said: Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldst enter under my roof; but only say the word and my servant shall be healed. For I also am a man subject to authority, having under me soldiers; and I say to this: Go, and he goeth; and to another; Come, and he cometh; and to my servant: Do this, and he doeth it. And Jesus hearing this marveled, and said to them that followed Him: Amen I say to you, I have not found so great faith in Israel. And I say to you, that many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven: but the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into the exterior darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. And Jesus said to the centurion: Go, and as thou hast believed, so be it done to thee. And the servant was healed at the same hour.

**OFFERTORY** *Psalm 129. 1-2.* From the depths I have cried out to Thee, O Lord; Lord, hear my prayer: from the depths I have cried out to Thee, O Lord.

**SECRET** May these offerings, we beseech Thee, O Lord, cleanse us from our sins, and sanctify the bodies and minds of Thy servants for the celebration of this Sacrifice. Through our Lord . . .
