The Order of Readings

Romans 13: 8-10

8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another. For he that loveth his neighbour, hath fulfilled the law. **9** For Thou shalt not commit adultery: Thou shalt not kill: Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness: Thou shalt not covet: and if there be any other commandment, it is comprised in this word, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. **10** The love of our neighbour worketh no evil. Love therefore is the fulfilling of the law.

Matthew 8: 23-27

23 And when he entered into the boat, his disciples followed him: **24** And behold a great tempest arose in the sea, so that the boat was covered with waves, but he was asleep. **25** And they came to him, and awaked him, saying: Lord, save us, we perish. **26** And Jesus saith to them: Why are you fearful, O ye of little faith? Then rising up he commanded the winds, and the sea, and there came a great calm. **27** But the men wondered, saying: What manner of man is this, for the winds and the sea obey him?
