## **DIRECTIONS TO ST. JOSEPH’S FROM ST PETER’S:**

- 1) Start by going north on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. towards Hoosick Street.
- 2) Turn left onto Hoosick Street.
- 3) Turn left onto River Street/Route 4
- 4) Continue on Route 4 about 2 miles. Route 4 becomes 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.
- 5) St. Joseph’s Church is on your left.

*St. Joseph’s Church is also easily accessible from Route 787. Taking the exit for Rt. 378 east, continue into Troy on Route 378. This becomes Route 4 north (Burden Street), at the ‘y’ stay right on 4<sup>th</sup> Street. St. Joseph’s will be on the left.*

**TODAY:** St. Joseph’s Church will be open to our parishioners this Sunday after Mass so we may become familiar with the church and neighborhood.

The liturgy for the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Easter teaches us to have confidence in prayer. We ought to pray above all that God’s kingdom will come on earth, that Christ may be served and honored and loved by all. “Ask and you shall receive, that your joy may be full.”

## **Order of Readings**

Epistle: James 1:22-27

Gospel: John 16: 23-30

**23** And in that day you shall not ask me any thing. Amen, amen I say to you: if you ask the Father any thing in my name, he will give it you. **24** Hitherto you have not asked any thing in my name. Ask, and you shall receive; that your joy may be full. **25** These things I have spoken to you in proverbs. The hour cometh, when I will no more speak to you in proverbs, but will shew you plainly of the Father. **26** In that day you shall ask in my name; and I say not to you, that I will ask the Father for you: **27** For the Father himself loveth you, because you have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. **28** I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again I leave the world, and I go to the Father. **29** His disciples say to him: Behold, now thou speakest plainly, and speakest no proverb. **30** Now we know that thou knowest all things, and thou needest not that any man should ask thee. By this we believe that thou camest forth from God.
