

CALLED TO BE CHURCH

St. Peter's, St. Paul's and St. Patrick's are merged into a single parish using one of the current church buildings as a worship site. The new name of the Parish would be determined through a mutually agreeable process. The new parish (which we will call temporarily "All Saints" for ease of writing) will be linked with St. Augustine's Church. Our Lady of Victory and Christ Sun of Justice will also be linked.

As we proceed into the future, this configuration will be evaluated on a regular basis and if "All Saints" is not able to sustain itself, the parish will be closed or merged.

The four parishes (Christ Sun of Justice linked to Our Lady of Victory and St. Augustine linked to All Saints) will themselves be linked to provide life-long formation, Christian service, Prayer and Worship, and administration wherever possible. That is, it is possible that Life-long Faith Formation will be a single program for all communities although there may be three models of Life-long Faith Formation that operate - one at each of three different sites. The same is true for other critical components of CALLED TO BE CHURCH.
