Corpus Christi

By Apostolic Indult, 25 Nov. 1885, the Solemnization of the Feast of Corpus Christi was transferred to the Sunday following [Thursday], and is now so observed.

“The joy over the institution of the Holy Eucharist is not sufficiently expressed on Holy Thursday because of the nearness to Good Friday. On Corpus Christi, wherever possible, public homage is paid to the Blessed Sacrament, sometimes with procession.”

Order of Readings

1 Corinthians 11: 23-29

23 For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus, the same night in which he was betrayed, took bread. 24 And giving thanks, broke, and said: Take ye, and eat: this is My body, which shall be delivered for you: this do for the commemoration of me. 25 In like manner also the chalice, after He had supped, saying: This chalice is the new testament in My blood: this do ye, as often as you shall drink, for the commemoration of Me. 26 For as often as you shall eat this bread, and drink the chalice, you shall shew the death of the Lord, until He come. 27 Therefore whosoever shall eat this bread, or drink the chalice of the Lord unworthily, shall be guilty of the Body and of the Blood of the

Lord. 28 But let a man prove himself: and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of the chalice. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh judgment to himself, not discerning the body of the Lord.

Sequence: “Lauda Sion”

John 6: 56-59

56 For My flesh is meat indeed: and My blood is drink indeed. 57 He that eateth My flesh, and drinketh my blood, abideth in me, and I in him. 58 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father; so he that eateth Me, the same also shall live by Me. 59 This is the bread that came down from heaven. Not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead. He that eateth this bread, shall live for ever.
