POVERTY IN THE DIOCESE of ALBANY

- . 13 percent of families in Albany are in "extreme poverty," living on less than half the federal poverty level of \$17,170 for a family of three;
- . 71 percent of families living in poverty in Albany County households are paying more than 35 percent of their income on rent, which is considered unaffordable by the federal government; and
- . 642 housing units in Albany lack plumbing.
