INTROIT: The Lord saith: I think thoughts of peace, and not of affliction: you shall call upon Me, and I will hear you; and I will bring back your captivity from all places. Ps. Lord, Thou hast blessed Thy land: Thou hast turned away the captivity of Jacob. ∅. Glory be...

COLLECT: Stir up the wills of Thy faithful people, we beseech Thee, O Lord: that more earnestly seeking the fruit of good works, they may receive more abundantly the gifts of Thy loving kindness. Through our Lord.

OFFERTORY: From the depths I have cried out to Thee, O Lord: Lord, hear my prayer: from the depths I have cried out to Thee, O Lord.

SECRET: May this oblation, O God, we beseech Thee, cleanse and renew, govern and protect us. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION: Amen I say to you, whatsoever you ask when you pray, believe that you shall receive, and it shall be done to you.

POST-COMMUNION: Grant unto us, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that through these Sacraments which we have received, whatsoever in our minds is corrupt, may be cured by the gift of their healing power. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost . . .

Notes Concerning the Advent Season

(2 December)

+ December 2nd begins “Winter” part of the Breviary

+ Nuptial solemnity of the Advent Season (2nd-26th of December)

+ Altar is not ornamented with flowers; the organ is silent, except to sustain the choir.

+ The “Gloria” is omitted on Sundays & days of the Feria.

+ The Proper Preface of Advent may be used on Sundays and Ferial days of Advent
